# TOWN CLERK / TOWN TREASURER'S REPORT – Sue Johnson

- Election turnout was high, over 50% of registered voters voted in presidential primaries and the local election.
- Next election will be the State primary on August 9.
- Dog licenses due on April 1
- Sue J. starts vacation on April 15, returns April 28. Joan B. will be covering the office for all the regular work days.
- The second half of property taxes are due May 1

# ROAD COMMISSIONER'S REPORT – Stu Johnson

- Town roads are in good shape.
- Large pothole on Route 74 at the end of Clarke Road was filled quickly by VTrans, after Stu J. alerted VTrans to the problem.
- Have 2/3 of sand in the shed left, after relatively easy winter.
- Stu J. met with VTrans to hear good news of plans to do major work on Route 74 in Cornwall sometime after July 1, 2016.
- Road department will be paving on West Street this year, installing
  multiple culverts. Stu J. would like to start before July 1. Sue J. will look
  into the budget logistics to make an early start possible.

### **OLD BUSINESS**

- Wooster Road business update John Roberts has drafted a letter to the Shoreham Select Board, expressing Cornwall's concerns. Board members will each sign the letter. Stu J. has requested a traffic count on Wooster. John R. will contact the Land Trust, which is also a stakeholder, because of conservation easement on the property. Buildings are not exempt from easement.
- Development Review Board (DRB)— meeting of interested candidates is scheduled for March 16. Next steps – appoint 5 members and 2 alternates at next Select Board meeting, VLCT training, attending meetings of operating DRBs, and training from Jim Carroll. The DRB needs a Secretary.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

- Ben M. stated that he will recuse himself in any discussions/decisions regarding retaining Jim Carroll as Town Attorney, due to a conflict of interest.
- Ben M. said that the Solar Ordinance may need to be tweaked to address issue of meeting the standard as it pertains to the view from inside the house, if the person in the house refuses entry.
- Ben M. recommended that the board look at Bill 230 introduced by Chris Bray on solar siting.

Ben W MOVED / Brian K. SECONDED a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed – 4 in favor, 0 opposed.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:15pm.
