NEW BUSINESS

- Street Signs and E-911 signs
 - [Dave Sears] The Fire Department has received information that some private roads do not have road signs. Recently the Fire Department was trying to locate a person having a medical

- emergency and had great difficulty finding the house, which was located on a private road with no road sign. Ben Wood suggested that this issue be added to the agenda of the next meeting so that it can be discussed with the Road Commissioner.
- [Dave Sears] Another issue is the fact that a significant number of homes in Cornwall do not have E-911 signs. One obstacle for some families may be the cost, estimated at \$50 for the E-911 sign and post upon which it is mounted. The following suggestions were made:
 - An Article at Town Meeting for funding sufficient to ensure that every home has an E-911 sign installed. Contact Katie Gieges for the number of homes missing an E-911 sign to estimate the cost.
 - The Fire Department could do the installation
 - Requiring the installation of an E-911 sign as a condition of subdivision approval. Ben Marks will discuss with Tracy Himmel Isham.
