Following up on Campers from the public hearing - The language in the hearing draft was taken from our current bylaws (Section 523). The only new language clarifies that after 90 days of use they are considered single family dwellings.

Other topics of discussion: Rural Enterprises, Event Venues, Conditional Use, Riparian Areas, Maps, Table of Contents/Appendices, Short Term Rentals

SECONDED a motion to remove Section 423 and Short Term Rentals from the draft based on feedback from the community at the hearing and in writing; and based on our own current knowledge of housing in Cornwall and our attempts at a number of revisions of this section to meet the goals of the Town Plan. The motion also sets forth that the topic of Short Term Rentals be continued to be reviewed by the Planning Commission for subsequent revisions or amendments to zoning updates, ordinances or the Town Plan. Motion passed - 4 in favor, 0 opposed.

Sarah P. MOVED /Conor S. SECONDED a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion passed - 4 in favor, 0 opposed.
