



In summary, a combination of rock type and bedrock structures (faults) results in wells in this area of Cornwall having above average well yield characteristics. Because the wells will be adequately spaced from each other and other wells in this area, there is very low to no potential for well interference impacts. Therefore, it is my professional opinion, based on 45 years of experience as a hydrogeologist, that water availability for two additional single family wells is of no concern.
