

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TOWN OF CORNWALL
DEVELOPMENT REVIEW BOARD

The Cornwall Development Review Board will hold a public hearing on Wednesday, May 1, 2024 at 7 pm.

The hearing will be held by Zoom and in person at the Town Hall. An online meeting link and a dial in number will be published on the agenda for the meeting, so that Board members, the applicant, and interested members of the public may participate electronically or by telephone. The agenda will be posted at least 48 hours before the hearing at the Town Hall and the Town Garage, and on the Town's website.

Purpose of the hearing:

To continue the hearing of an application for site plan review brought by Andrea Landsberg, CORA Committee Member, on behalf of the Town of Cornwall, in connection with plans for an outdoor recreation area to be located on a 2-acre parcel owned by the Town of Cornwall and located off School Road in the Cornwall Village zoning district. The first hearing was held on March 6, 2024.

You are free to review the file for any additional information concerning this particular matter.

Please note that in accordance with Chapter 117, Section 4464, of the Vermont statutes, participation in this public hearing is a prerequisite to the right to make subsequent appeal.
